Image Smarter.

5-Hour Ultrasound CE

This training course is perfect for the new ultrasound user, DVM, or technician. The scanning sessions will be customized to the skill level of the end user. Only 1 – 5 hour RACE CE will be given.





Learn basic veterinary abdominal ultrasound skills. AAVSB RACE approved.

Part One

This AAVSB RACE-approved CE course will begin with a 1 hour live virtual session with a veterinary sonographer for system overview and set-up. Initial tips for optimization and image acquisition will be taught.

Part Two

The next step will be watching two recorded videos. The first 1-hour video will be on basic prep, patient positioning, transducer knowledge, image acquisition and ultrasound artifacts. In the second section (also 1 hour) you will be shown an abdominal protocol with image acquisition and organ identification. You will learn where each organ is located, how to pan/scan through the entire organ and how to acquire images to send to the radiologist. These sessions will not include any image interpretation, only image acquisition instruction.

Part Three

The additional 2 hours will be live virtual scanning sessions with your animals, (in 1-hour scheduled periods) with a trained veterinary sonographer. The tools given in the recorded videos will be implemented. During this time we will also review scanning planes and how to identify abnormal pathology and/or anatomy. Additional instruction on image optimization of your ultrasound system and how to send studies to a radiologist for interpretation will be taught.
